FEBRUARY 19, 2007

THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COBB COUNTY RETIRED EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION WAS HELD AT **WEST COBB SENIOR CENTER** WITH 50 IN ATTENDANCE.

WE WERE GIVEN A COPY OF THE 2006 FINANCIAL REPORT WITH A BALANCE OF \$1,864.88 AND RUBY LOWRY, TREASURER, REPORTED A CURRENT BALANCE OF CASH ON HAND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,984.88. A COPY OF THE SECRETARY'S REPORT WAS GIVEN TO US AND A MOTION WAS MADE AND SECONDED THAT IT BE ACCEPTED.

PRES. STORY THANKED EVERYONE ASSISTING IN PREPARATION OF THE CHRISTMAS MEAL. HE ANNOUNCED THAT ON APRIL 24TH FROM 9 TIL 1 THERE WILL BE A CLASS ON DEFENSIVE DRIVING AT THE CENTER AND WE WERE ASKED TO SIGN UP IF WE ARE INTERESTED.
