Sgt. Pierce mention that we should check our hospital bills to make sure there are no added charges. When using your credit card to shop online, make sure you keep a check on it before 30 days. The credit card company won't back you up after 30 days. Also, it is best to have a specific card to be used just for online shopping.

Be careful using Wi-Fi at places like Star Buck for example, know that these are unsecure locations and your personal information can be in jeopardy. You need to check your credit at least once a year, and change your password frequently. Never carry you Social Security Card on you. When using your credit card, on back where the signature goes, put CID (check ID) or please check ID. Be aware of Medicare and Medicaid fraud, Telemarking and charity scams.
